## *Gift Aid Declaration*

On 6th April 2000, the Inland Revenue introduced new rules to make it easier for charities to reclaim tax. If you are a taxpayer then it would help us if you could sign this declaration. ### **Notes**

- 1. You can cancel this declaration at any time by notifying us.*
- 2. You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that we reclaim on your donations in the tax year (currently 28p for each £1 you give).*
- 3. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that we reclaim, you can cancel your declaration (see note 1).*
- 4. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.*
- 5. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, please ask us or ask your local tax office for leaflet IR113 Gift Aid.*
- 6. Please notify us if you change your name or address.*
